The three themes

1) My lifelong learning skills

These are skills such as communication, teamwork, self-management and problem solving skills. Examine where you are in terms of developing these lifelong learning skills.

2) Content of my studies

Look at the big picture of your subject area. Ask yourself how you would describe your studies to someone outside the university system. For example, explain how the different topics you are studying link together and why they are important.

3) Preparing for my future career

Demonstrate your understanding of your future area of employment and show your thinking and involvement that goes beyond what is required directly for your studies. For example give an outline of your career plan, or a description of your skills and competences.
